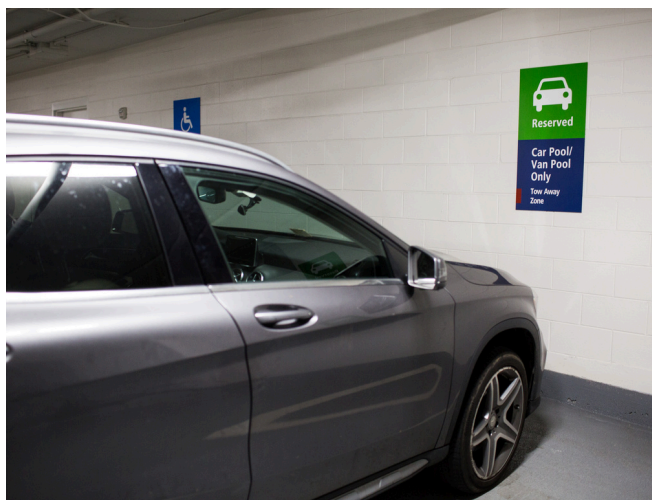


Examples of commuter benefits offered:
