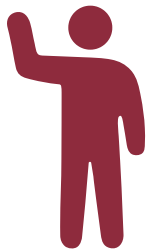

The 2025 A Better Tomorrow Awards Data Report highlights how organizations across the U.S. are advancing sustainable transportation and mobility solutions.

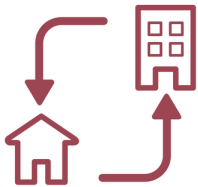

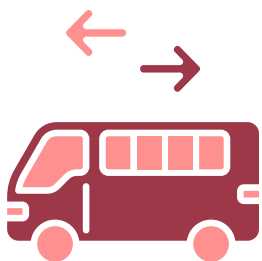

Including subsidized transit, pre-tax commuting options, and incentives for sustainable travel

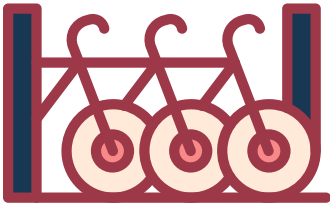


32% Operate Private Shuttles

Representing an annual ridership of more than 311 million



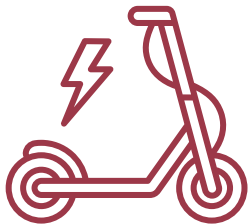
64% Support Biking Programs

Including financial incentives, bike-share access, and end-of-trip facilities



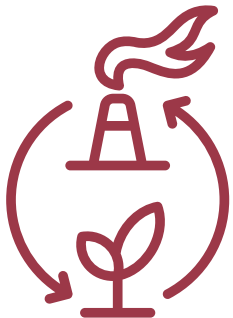
Manage More Than 300,000 Carpools

The number of recipients with formal carbon reduction plans decreased by 13% from 2024
